

Urban Design Certificate Program

The certificate requires 12–15 credits of coursework as outlined below. Note that classes required by degree programs frequently have urban design content, but only those taken in addition to required core or restricted elective/“selective” courses count towards the 12–15 unique certificate credits, though certificate credits may count as free electives toward total degree credits. Graduate students should enroll in 500-level courses where 400/500 options are available.
